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

WHO'S WHO

Meet Susie Broderick!

I have had the extreme pleasure of working as a facilitator with the Colorado Home Intervention Program for over 30 years. I have learned that our work to truly empower families and to guide and to support them in their journey is very fulfilling yet also very challenging. I recognize what an honor and privilege it is to work with and learn alongside families as they evolve and grow in their journey to best support their child who is Deaf/Hard of Hearing. I think one of the things I am most proud of in my work with families is my ability to truly join a family. The art of joining a family pushes us to be authentic, present, and to suspend judgement. Sometimes that means that we need to be more of a listener than a coach, that our suggestions and opinions are just that, and that we essentially believe that families know their child best and will make the best decision for their child. In challenging moments or times when I feel frustrated, I strive to have the mindset that families are doing the best they can in that given moment. One aspect of my work that I have tried to refine over the years in my sessions with families is to do more modeling than talking and to leave enough time at the end of a session to recap strategies I have modeled. I then invite families to identify the strategy that they will weave into their daily routines for that week. I have found that using this structure helps me to clearly model strategies, but to ultimately empower families to make it their own and to apply the learned strategies to their day-to-day lives.

I currently work in three different counties with three different CCBs; I love this because it provides me the amazing support from three different CO-Hears, which I find to be invaluable. Throughout the years this relationship has added so much to my work, and the support shared has allowed me to refine my practice and to continue to grow and learn as a facilitator. I wholeheartedly encourage everyone to utilize their CO-Hears! When I am not working you'll find me enjoying time with my husband, Greg and our daughter, Alia, or relaxing or practicing yoga in our Coal Creek mountain home, but more likely you'll find us adventuring in the outdoors skiing the deepest powder, rafting rivers, mountain biking, or hiking the mountain trails right out our front door!

"As I reflect on my own professional journey, I have realized that families have truly been MY teacher and that they have taught me so many valuable lessons along the way."
