Addition the Blind and the El school students sep	lest Hall was constructed in 1931 and is largely still in its original condition. The only major additions or upgrades to the building have been fire alarm, 1960s lighting upgrade and a roof replacement planned in 2023. The building desperately needs a complete renovation and an addition added to accommodate the School for the Blind, Early Education Program (EEP) and make the facility ADA accessible. It is currently housing the School for the Blind and has become too small to adequately accommodate the growing student opulation. Additionally, the EEP has also outgrown it's current facility because of its growing student population. Moving the School for e Blind and the EEP to West Hall (a multi-story building) will provide more space and facilitate teaching elementary, middle and high hool students separately on each floor as done in the School for the Deaf. After the addition, the Blind School will be approximately the me size as the Deaf School, both with similar student/staff populations.
